## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

These terms will govern the relationship between Maritime Plymouth and its members.

### **MEMBERSHIP**

Maritime Plymouth is a company limited by guarantee. There are three categories of membership, namely full corporate, full individual membership and associate membership. Full members are also members of the company, with liabilities limited to £1.00

Full corporate membership shall be open to all marine businesses and organisations.

Full individual membership shall be open to all individuals.

Associate membership will be available to marine businesses, organisations and individuals not wishing to take up full membership.

The rights of associate members shall be limited to receipt of the newsletter and participation in any programmes implemented by the organisation.

Membership of Maritime Plymouth does not include registration as a “friend” on the Maritime Plymouth website which is free to all. Members will still need to register themselves to gain access to the friends’ area.

### **REGISTRATION**

On registration, you must provide Maritime Plymouth with accurate, complete registration information and thereafter inform Maritime Plymouth if that information changes.

Membership is non-transferable.

### **DUTIES OF MEMBERS**

Members shall ensure that all membership information and forms are maintained and submitted to Maritime Plymouth as required.

Members shall promptly pay all dues and fees owed to Maritime Plymouth.

Every full member of the Company undertakes to contribute to the assets of the Company, in the event of the same being wound up while he is a member, or within one year after he ceases to be a member, for payment of the debts and liabilities of the Company contracted before he ceases to be a member and of the costs, charges and expenses of winding up and for the adjustment of the rights of the contributories among themselves, such amount as may be required not exceeding £1.00.

### **PAYMENT**

The annual membership fee shall be £50 for full corporate members, £15 for full individual members, and free for associate members.

In the event that having applied for membership of Maritime Plymouth and you decide that you do not want to be a member you may cancel your application provided that you notify us of such cancellation within 7 working days of the date of receipt of your application by us. In such event we will refund to you the membership fee paid by you. If you wish to exercise your right of cancellation you may do so by sending notice of the cancellation to The Chairman.

Annual subscriptions are to be paid by 31 January each year. New members joining before 1 June will pay a full year's subscription; those joining after 1 June will pay 50% of the annual subscription.

Payment of the membership fee shall entitle members to receive a range of benefits developed by Maritime Plymouth details of which will be supplied as and when they become available.

### RESIGNATION

Any member may withdraw from membership of Maritime Plymouth at any time for any reason by giving written notice to Maritime Plymouth.

If a member fails to pay his/her membership subscription fee for more than two months, Maritime Plymouth will presume that the member has withdrawn his/her membership.

### TERMINATION

If a complaint is made against a member the General Committee shall discuss the problem privately with the member and if appropriate encourage him or her to remedy the problem.

If the problem cannot be resolved in this manner, a member shall be given at least 14 days written notice to attend a meeting of the General Committee and written details of the complaints made against him or her. The member shall have a right to appear before the General Committee to answer the complaints made against him or her.

After the General Committee has heard all the evidence and taken into consideration all the facts, the General Committee shall vote and if two thirds of the General Committee then present vote in favour of his or her expulsion, the membership will be terminated.
